## **COMMUNITY PLACEMENT & CASE MANAGEMENT (CPCM) PROGRAM**

A Holistic Community-Based Alternative to Immigration Detention for Children

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SUKA Society's CPCM Programme uses a holistic case management approach centred around child well-being and rights. One of the core programme components is finding safe, permanent and stable home environments for unaccompanied and separated children (UASC) in Malaysia through community placement.

## THE CPCM PROGRAM

The program has case managed 56 unaccompanied children since 2015.

- Myanmar

## **KEY SUCCESSES**



No child absconded from community placements



All children remained engaged with the migration resolution process



All children received material support for housing, food and basic healthcare



89% of children in need of health interventions were supported



96% of children gained access to education



Significantly improved overall well-being of the children while costing 90% less than immigration detention

A 2019 independent evaluation by Lighthouse Partnerships of the CPCM has shown that it can help avoid costly, harmful and unnecessary immigration detention of UASC in Malaysia.
